Methodology Statement

In May 2024, a change of suppliers was made to the hotel occupancy data. The data in this report is now provided by Amadeus, a hotel market data company, from their constantly growing panel of hotels across the UK.

This data set represents approximately a third of the estimated market so should be used as an indication of trends rather than the picture of the whole market.

Amadeus collects the following performance metrics from participating hotel on a daily basis through their online platform or data feeds:

- Number of rooms available
- Number of rooms sold
- Total room revenue

These baseline figures are used to calculate the three most relevant metrics within the accommodation industry namely: Occupancy, Average Daily Rate (ADR) and Revenue Per Available Room (RevPAR). All units given throughout this report represent a positive number, unless stated otherwise.

To allow a meaningful comparison of year-on-year trends, VisitEngland has included historical data from Amadeus in this reports from January 2019 onwards.


Summary of Results

- •Overall, **2023** was a strong year for **hotel room occupancy** with rates higher than 2019 across all months of the year. Room occupancy for 2024 so far has been higher than 2023 across all months so far, with a high of 85% occupancy observed in July 2024. Occupancy for 2024 so far (until the end of August) was 77%, +2% on 2023.
- •Observing forward looking **occupancy for 2024**. As of the 22nd September, upcoming occupancy rates for stand at 80% already for September, 39% for October, 20% for November and 15% for December.
- •Whilst **Average Daily Rates** were down 2% year on year for May, there was growth June-August of 2024. **RevPAR** (**Revenue per Available Room**) grew throughout May-August with the highest year on year increase in August, of 7%.
- •Regionally: some Northern regions saw strong year on year growth in occupancy throughout May, whilst the South East and South West were on par / slight decline.
- •June saw more modest growth overall (+1% compared to 2023) and this has resulted in some regions seeing a decline in occupancy, including the South West which experienced a -4% year on year decline.
- •Many regions were on par or saw declines in August, however London occupancy rates were +4% year on year.




