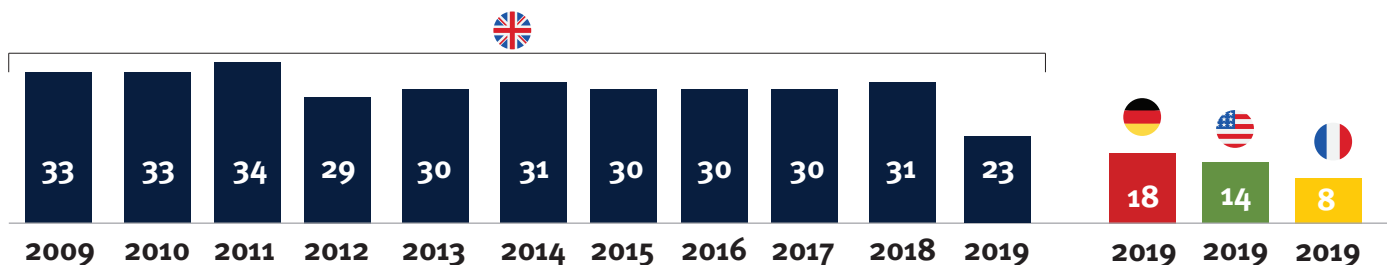

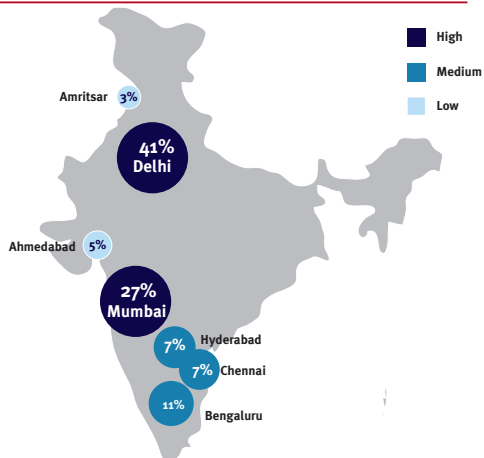
Weekly seat capacity to the UK per airline



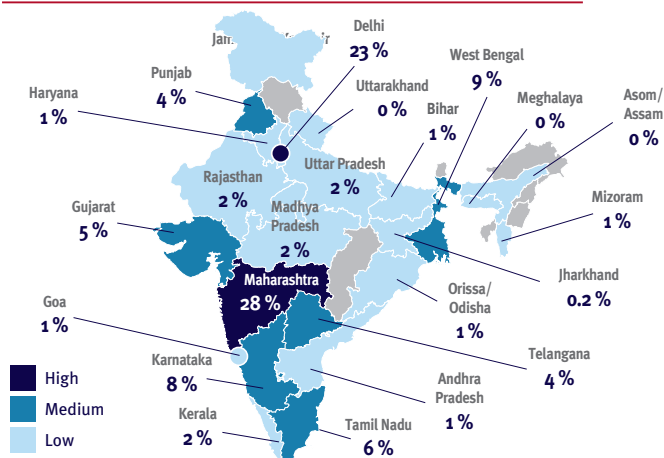
Weekly seat capacity to the UK and competitors (in oos)

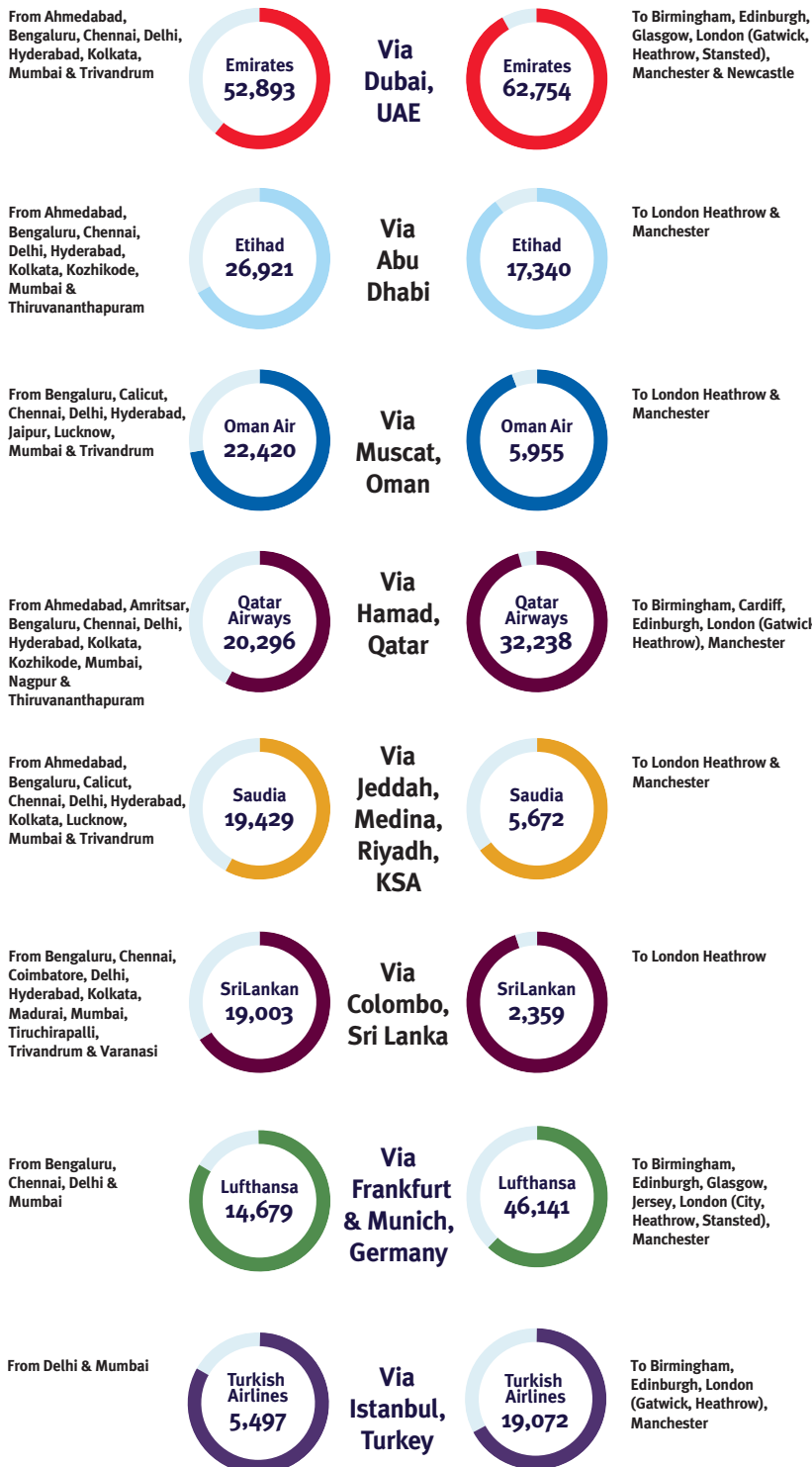
Notes:

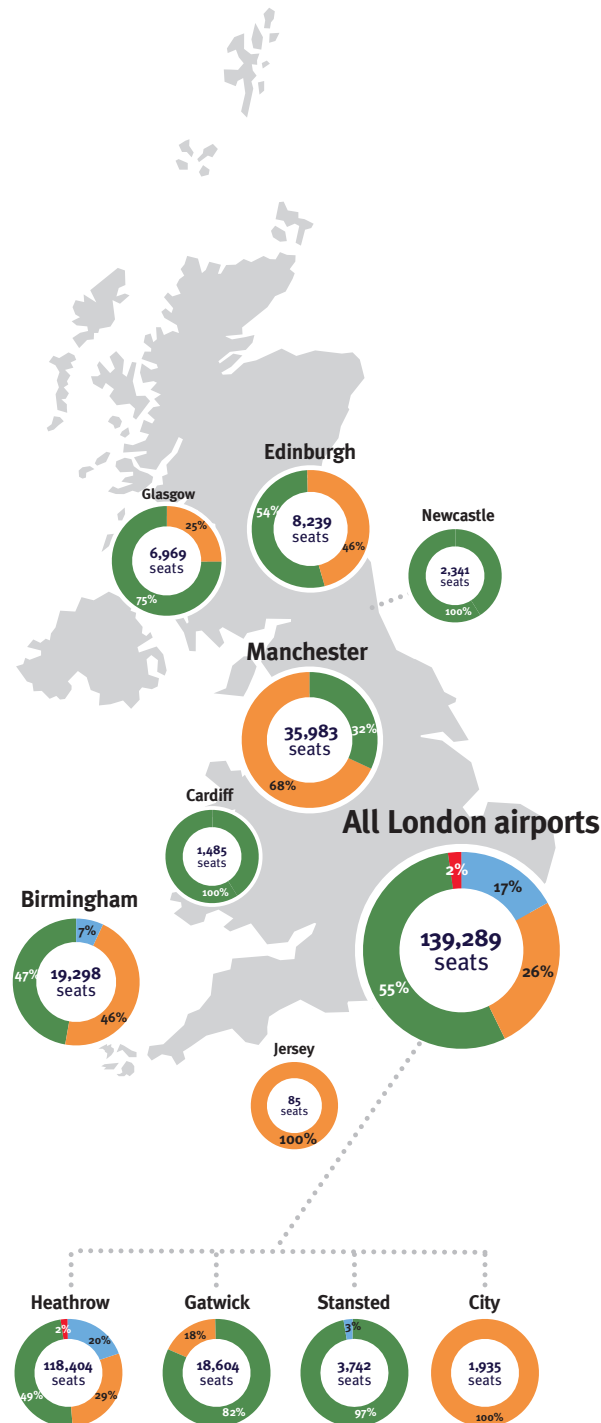
